Lions 14T Photo Contest

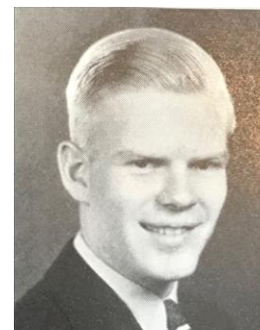
